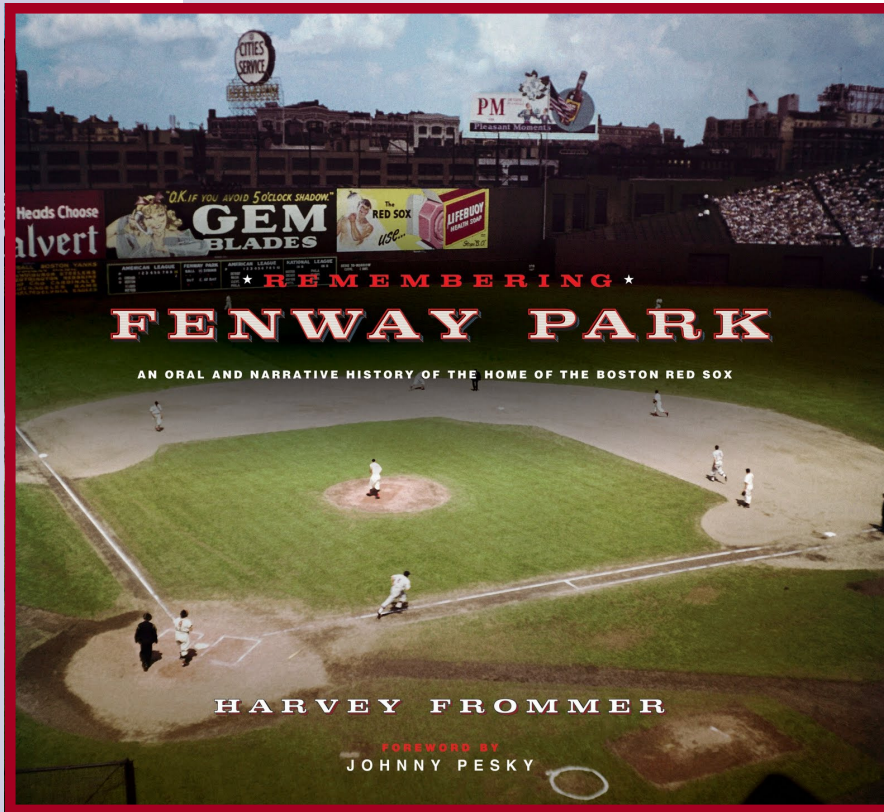


Whittemore Library Sports Author Series
